

CHAP. LXXVIII.

An Act to establish the town of Cherryfield in the
County of Washington.

SEC. 1. **BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That the township numbered eleven, (of the Lottery townships) commonly called Cherryfield in the county of Washington, as described within the following bounds, be, and hereby is estab-^{Boundaries.} lished as a town, by the name of Cherryfield: viz. east by the town of Columbia, south partly by the town of Steuben, and partly by the town of Harrington, west by the township numbered ten, and north by the township numbered seventeen: And the said town of Cherryfield is hereby vested with all the corporate powers and privileges, and shall be subject to the like duties and requisitions of other corporate towns, according to the Constitution and Laws of this Commonwealth.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That any Justice of the Peace for the county of Washington be, and he is hereby empowered to issue a warrant directed to a free-^{Justice to issue} hold inhabitant of the said town of Cherryfield, requir-^{warrant.} ing him to notify and warn the inhabitants thereof, to meet at such convenient time and place as shall be appointed in the said warrant, for the choice of such officers as towns are by law empowered and required to choose at their annual town meetings.
